Covid Guidelines for LSASC Training Pools

Further to the easing of restrictions as from 19.07.2021, we have been liasing with our pool providers and SE about future arrangements for use of training facilities.

Please note, we are subject to meeting the requirements of our individual pool operators and these vary between different facilities.

There will no longer be a requirement for a Covid Officer to be present at training sessions.

This guidance will be updated as and when we are notified by pool providers or SE of required changes.

As at 22.07.2021, the following is now in effect:-

Newbold Common Leisure Centre:-

- All previous restrictions removed
- Spectators allowed
- Changing facilities available for use

St. Nicks Leisure Centre

- All previous restrictions remain in place
- Use of face masks for all members of appropriate age mandatory on attending & leaving the Centre
- Swimmers must attend beach ready
- No changing room facilities available

King Henrys School

- All previous restrictions removed
- Spectators allowed
- Changing facilities available for use

Warwick Boys School

- All previous restrictions largely remain in place
- Use of face masks for all members of appropriate age mandatory on attending & leaving the Centre
- Swimmers can now enter the Centre on their own through the main entrance and should meet in the green gym
- Swimmers must attend beach ready and enter the pool through doors half way down poolside
- Changing facility available post training (subject to Coach discretion)

Alan Higgs, Coventry

- All previous restrictions removed
- Spectators allowed
- Changing facilities available for use
- Swimmers can enter the venue via the main reception
